Provincial Appropriateness of Care Program Inventory

Improving Appropriateness of Care (AC) has been a priority for the provincial healthcare system for the last few years. The provincial AC program team has been working collaboratively with the Ministry of Health, the Health Quality Council (HQC), the Saskatchewan Medical Association (SMA) and health regions to build the system's capacity to support clinicians to lead and participate in improving clinical appropriateness.

Efforts include development and testing a provincial AC framework, initiating several provincial AC projects, collaborating with Choosing Wisely Saskatchewan, providing physicians with opportunities to improve their knowledge and skills for leading and participating in clinical quality improvement (QI) projects through the Clinical Quality Improvement Program (CQIP) and the SMA's Appropriateness of Care Initiative (SACI).

There is growing interest from health regions and physicians in improving AC in Saskatchewan. The Provincial AC Program Team has collected information on AC/clinical QI projects underway at the regional level to develop a provincial AC inventory. The following criteria for AC/Clinical QI projects were provided to health regions to identify their projects:

- Projects led or participated in by clinicians, taking place in clinical settings (no administrative improvement);
- Projects aligned with clinical quality improvement goals such as:
 - Reducing inappropriate/unnecessary treatments, testing and screening;
 - Increasing uptake/uses of clinical best practices, guidelines and decision support tools supported by scientific evidence;
 - Reducing clinical variation; and
- Reducing medical errors/patient harm related to clinical practices.

The AC inventory will be used to better coordinate and align AC efforts across the system, facilitate replication of successful projects, identify where the gaps exist, and provide better support to build capacity for improving clinical appropriateness.
